The Initial Study and Notice of Preparation (NOP) for the Environmental Impact Report (EIR) has just been issued by the Planning Department (posted on [www.CrestmontPreservation.org](http://www.CrestmontPreservation.org)). Your written comments and objections to the 34 unit Crestmont Hills Condominium Project must reach the Planning Department before June 26 to be considered.

Tell the Planning Department that you are concerned about:

- Increased traffic which this development would bring to your street
- Increased hazards due to excessive traffic and speeding
- Safety issues, noise, and traffic during construction
- Increased parking congestion in Forest Knolls by new condo residents driving and parking closer to public transportation
- Increased density in the neighborhood
- Condominium development out of character with our neighborhood and opens the door for even more development in future
- Further instability of the hillside in an already unstable area – recent slide on upper Warren, previous mudslide at Oakhurst Stairs between Crestmont and Warren
- Loss of only accessible open space in area
